ConexiHon reports on the unequal treatment by the Honduran judicial system of local inhabitants denouncing the activities of a solar energy company (their legal complaints are ignored) and of the criminalization of the inhabitants by the company (the judicial system takes it up and brings the human rights defenders to court).

The article writes about the situation around the municipality of Namasique, Choluteca, where several communities protest against the imposition of a solar power plant Los Prados by the company Scatec Solar. 14 local human rights defenders are accused of coercion. In a initial audience, a judge decided that they can await trial with alternative measures to imprisonment, i.e. they have to sign in regularly at the court house and are not allowed to participate in protest. Furthermore, the judge decided to dispatch Military Police agents for the "protection" of the company for six months. One of the defendants lawyers denounces that the judge has become an ally of the company rather than an independent body.

After protests by the political opposition for possible links between the company and the National Party, the TSE had canceled the contract with it. Nevertheless, the TSE continues to claim that the elections will be transparent given the 15'000 electoral observer they expect to be in Honduras at that time.

Luis Zelaya demanded an investigation into the links between JOH, Pepe Lobo and drug trafficking.

As the article made headlines in Honduras, the JOH administration published a press release claiming that Los Cachiros want to discredit JOH and that the claims linking the National Party to drug trafficking are false.

The TSE signed the contract with the company responsible to transmit the electoral results yesterday.

Both the Liberal Party and the Opposition Alliance have announced that they won't accept the underlying system used to transfer the election results.
