El Pulso published an overview of day two (Friday) of the nation-wide strike.

The strike will continue next week and it seems to grow in strength as more than 5000 IHSS employees just announced to join in.

The protesters even received support from an unexpected side, the Chamber of Commerce and Industries of Cortés.

There is now also some international coverage, for example by Democracy Now! and Peoples Dispatch.

Most article highlight that the protests are not anymore just against the controversial decrees threatening the public education and health sector with privatization and massive lay-offs, but it developed into a widespread protest against the JOH regime.

Padre Melo summarized it as follows: "There is no way to be found to end social conflictivity that does not involve the resignation of the head of State. Everywhere you look, Juan Orlando Hernández is the problem. Once again the [US] Embassy is wrong to support the person who lost the confidence of the majority of society."

Amnesty International denounces the brutal repression by state security forces against the protesters (see also yesterday). "It is shameful that instead of guaranteeing the rights of its population, the Honduran government continues opting to repress demonstrations with the indiscriminate use of tear gas and lethal weapons, in violation of international standards."

But repression continued and it the campesino community Guadalupe Carney was especially targeted. The campesino organizations CNTC and MCA denounced that state security forces shot live bullets at protesters and beat them wounding five persons, among them an eight-year old boy.

Representatives of the public education and health sector announce that the protests will continue today and tomorrow.

Yesterday, they received support from the labor union CGT calling for the derogation of the disputed executive decrees.

The repression of the two-day national strike was very brutal as highlighted in the last e-mails. The Honduras Solidarity Network linked on Twitter to additional videos and photos of the repression and its results.

Especially targeted by state repression is the Bajo Aguán. When campesino communities there also joined the nationwide protests, they were attacked by the military and police, as happened in Guadalupe Carney in Trujillo, Colón (see also yesterday).

The community denounced that soldiers were flown in by helicopters and that they shot live bullets at protesters.

Honduras Daily: Public Sector - Analysis; Journalists; Corruption - JOH, Narcopolítica, Cuéllar; and Tony's Drug Plane

Yesterday, the JOH regime announced the derogation of the two controversial decrees in what it presented as a dialogue, but which was not accepted by most protesters, especially the Platform for the Defense of Education and Healthcare. They denounced it as a demobilization strategy by the regime.

It is also indicative of the regime's strategies that those representative of the education and health sector participating faced threats of government persecution due to financial irregularities (3rd link).

MADJ published a press release denouncing this tactic.

The Platform for the Defense of Education and Healthcare announced that the protests will continue for the time being.

There was a big march in Tegucigalpa where the IHSS employees joined in, but there also continued to be protest outside the capital.

Reporteros de Investigación portrayed a protest in Santa Ana and COPINH tweeted about the successful resistance to state repression against a highway occupation in Siguatepeque.

As announced, the nationwide protests continued yesterday, the sixth consecutive day.

The president of the Liberal Party, Luis Zelaya, also participated and warned the public education and health sector of falling into the trap of a false dialogue with the JOH regime.

Already Monday has shown, that this does not seem to be the case and yesterday, the Platform for the Defense of Education and Healthcare presented seven conditions that need to be fulfilled to start a dialogue.

While yesterday's protest in Tegucigalpa was not repressed as usual, maybe as a PR tool to show the international community that the JOH regime is ready for talks, repression has not stopped in the rest of the country.

The campesino community Guadalupe Carney remains militarized and under siege.

Human rights organizations filed a Habeas Corpus in favor of the community.

Four young Hondurans, including a 12-year old, were detained in La Lima, south of San Pedro Sula.

In El Progreso, the situation was especially bad as the Honduras Solidarity Network denounced. "At least 4 young people have been badly beaten & are being held in police station in city of El Progreso. Military & police are chasing protesters into large sugar cane fields causing panic & uncertainty about the well-being & whereabouts of those being chased #Honduras".

Pasos de Animal Grande denounces that the doctor Ligia Ramos was tear gased when she arrived to support other protesters on Monday before the casa presidencial.

Defensores en Línea reports on the violent repression in La Paz.

Radio Progreso rhetorically asks how one cannot call the state security forces criminals. "The actions of the National Police and the Military Police in the face of the recent demonstrations

against the privatization of health and public education reflect a systematic pattern that has not changed with the new curriculum or with the much publicized purification process. (...) When police and military agents repress violently, use their firearms against the unarmed people and use brute force indiscriminately, they violate the Constitution, international treaties and other laws of the republic. Therefore, what is the name of those who violate laws and commit crimes? Criminals. And criminals are those who let the crime pass and do not conduct an investigation promptly, impartially, independently and effectively."

CEJIL denounced the repression in a press release.

Honduras Daily: Public Sector - Repression, Denigration, Analysis; Hydroelectricity - Reitoca; Corruption - Journalists, Narcopolítica; Armed Forces; Transparency; and the Many Faces of Violence

The Platform for the Defense of Education and Healthcare announced a partial return to work which includes assemblies to discuss the propose dialogue. They also announced new protests for the weekend if things remain the same. At the same time, protests and road blocks continue.

There is some criticism regarding this step, i.e. a partial withdrawal, by the platform.

But the situation is as clear cut. Suyapa Figueroa, the president of the Medical Association of Honduras (CMH), told media outlets that they cannot join a dialogue while a gun is being held to their heads.

The platform also demanded an international mediator.

The JOH regime remained numb to such demands and held a first day of dialogue yesterday without the presence of the platform.

As the situation in Honduras remains tense, there is also more international coverage. Nina Lakhani writes for the Guardian on how the protests came about and the violent repression by the JOH regime. "The current wave of social unrest was triggered by privatization reforms that critics warned would kill off public education and health services. This week, Hernández withdrew the proposed legislation, but more strikes and protests are planned for the coming days despite the militarized crackdown. "The people are on the streets because the crisis is extreme, and they have been betrayed too many times by this government, which is no longer recognized as credible or legitimate," said Dr Suyapa Figueroa, president of the Honduras Medical College and leader of the fledgling Platform for the Defense of Education and Health. "We are willing to dialogue but only with representatives who are honest, knowledgeable, and have no conflicts of interest, not those chosen by this illegal government," Figueroa added."

Radio Progreso dissects the smear campaign against the protesters. "It is true that both crime and social protest are nourished by poverty, unemployment, rising prices, corruption, abandonment of the countryside by the State, and ultimately, the unfair distribution of wealth. But in comparison to crime which is clearly associated with powerful groups in the country connected to organized crime and corrupt public institutions and officials, social protest has no organizational relationship with crime. Social protest has a direct relationship with the just complaints and discomforts of the poor. And these claims have been increasing to the extent that public policies enlarge inequalities and respond more to the interests of mafias than to the realities of the country. As inequality continues to grow, it is an ethical responsibility to participate in social protests, and it is an obligation to decontaminate them from leaders or political groups interested in manipulating them. Social protests are good news when they express the will of the population to channel their discontent in an organized way and demand answers to their clamor."

OFRANEH's Miriam Miranda sent out words of support for Suyapa Figueroa, a special target of smear and hate campaigns.

Even though some members of the Platform for the Defense of Education and Healthcare temporarily withdrew to discuss the options on the table, the Honduran people continue to protest in various cities. The platform also announced that they will return to the streets the next week if there are no satisfying answers by the JOH regime.

Yesterday, the initial hearing against the young teacher Ronmel Valdemar Herrera Portillo took place. He is being criminalized for setting fire to tires outside the US embassy.

The judge decided to open trial with pre-trial detention. Portillo had to return to the high-security prison La Tolva.

A protest in support of him was held outside the court.

In a press release, the US Cross Border Network raises question about the narrative presented by the US and the Honduran authorities regarding the fire. Some of its members were inside the embassy as part of a human rights delegation when it happened.

Nevertheless, the US embassy almost daily fuels the criminalization of Portillo by publishing press releases or tweeting claiming that they had to temporarily stop the emissions of visas at the embassy implying that it is Portillo's fault.

In Guapinol, nationally known for its resistance to a mining project, inhabitants blocked a road in solidarity with the nationwide protests and to reiterate their demand for the derogation of the mining concession in their area. They were repressed by the national police and the Military Police, but they stood their ground. The police then went to the community itself to raid various houses and arrested and arrested at least four people.

According to the Honduras Solidarity Network, eight youths had been arrested but they were later released after the people of Guapinol had mobilized.

ConexiHon published an interview with a university student giving testimony of the repression suffered by her and her colleagues.

COPINH denounces repression in Siguatepeque as well as the illegal detention of buses full of COPINH members on their way back from protests in Siguatepeque.

While the Coalition against Immunity documented 49m protests around the country, the situation further worsened yesterday.

In the night from Wednesday to Thursday, at least two protesters were killed, one was shot by the Military Police in the head. In Tegucigalpa alone, at least 12 protesters were treated in the University Hospital for injuries due to repression.

OACNUDH has additionally documented 19 injured protesters, 16 by fire arms.

They also confirm the two deaths and demand an investigation.

A report by the University Hospital counted 21 injured, 17 of which by fire arms, and two deaths.

COPINH links to a video showing a young protester unconscious - he had been beaten by the police.

IM-Defensoras emitted an alert.

Reporteros de Investigación published photographic and videographic material of the protests and the repression.

The JOH regime and its security forces continue to repress its people. As a result, another protester, the 17-year old Eblin Noel Maradiaga, was shot dead yesterday by the Military Police.

The OACNUDH "profoundly regrets" his death, sending out a message of solidarity with his family. They also demand an investigation.

According to COFADEH, five people died between June 19 and June 20 due to military repression.

But state security forces continue to use live bullets to repress people. "Coordinator of Popular Organizations of the Aguan (COPA) denounces that live bullets were fired by Honduran military about two hours ago at campesinos in the Aguan Valley region during an eviction. Two young people were injured by bullet & various others were tortured".

Amnesty International wrote an open letter to JOH demanding to stop the violence. "The Honduran authorities must not continue on the path of violence and repression. We urge the administration of Juan Orlando Hernández to guarantee the rights to freedom of expression and freedom of peaceful assembly, and limit the use of force to a proportional minimum to avoid further injuries and deaths."

In a press release, CEJIL also demands a stop of state repression.

There is also a solidarity message with COFADEH and the Honduran people from several Latin American human rights organization.

In this context, the JOH regime also tries to criminalize the lawyer and HRD Mario Amílcar Portillo Contreras. Even though he tried to mediate, he is being presented as an organizer of the protests. FIDH and OMCT express their concerns about his criminalization and the threats launched against him. They demand a stop to this.

Yesterday, nine indigenous Tolupán defenders faced their initial hearing. The start of this criminalizing trial was accompanied by a press release signed by more than 100 national and international human rights organizations condemning it. "We demand an immediate end to the prosecution of the nine Tolupan land defenders currently charged. Likewise, we ask the authorities to cease the violence, discrimination, and criminalization of the Tolupan tribe of San Francisco Locomapa and to guarantee their rights over their ancestral territory, protect their lives and punish those who have systematically violated their human rights. Finally, we lend our solidarity to the

legitimate and dignified defense exercised by the Tolupan defenders and call on the national and international community to closely follow and demand justice for their case."

The nine Tolupán defenders are members of MADJ and they are accompanied by MADJ lawyers. MADJ additionally published an overview of the case which goes back at least to 2010.

OACNUDH will accompany the process.

Students at the UNAH in Tegucigalpa held various solidarity protests these last weeks. Yesterday, the UNAH was suddenly stormed by the Military Police who opened fire on students. At least five students were injured by bullets and dozens suffered from the tear gas attacks. Once more, the autonomy of UNAH guaranteed in the constitution was violated.

OACNUDH published several Tweets denouncing the attacks and sending a message of solidarity with the injured students. Once more, they felt compelled to remind the JOH regime that "[e]xceptional circumstances such as internal political instability or any other public emergency situation can not be invoked to justify breaching the Basic Principles on the use of force".

In the evening, the students denounced that they are being held captive on university grounds.

UNAH dean Francisco Herrera condemned the violent repression.

For a second day in a row, the Military Police attacked students. Yesterday, they went after students at the Technical Institute of Honduras (ITH).

In an additional protest in Choluteca, people fled from state security forces repression into a mall, but they were followed and shot at. A man handing out leaflets inside the mall was shot in the leg.

Human rights defender and former UNAH dean Juan Almendarez Bonilla looks back on Monday's state violence at the UNAH. "I am writing to the university community, the entire Honduran people and the international community to condemn the violation of university autonomy that occurred on June 24 in the afternoon, when Military Police troops violently entered the university and in an act of terror hunted protesters, resulting in 8 injuries, 2 of them extremely grave. Since the arrival of 300 US Marines, in this time of great insurrectionary protests of the people, the government has felt stronger and therefore has become more repressive."

Talking to Criterio, Bonilla also said that UNAH has to take a clear position to be with the people.

As already written yesterday, UNAH filed an official complaint which ConfidencialHN now has published.

Former police commissioner María Luisa Borjas denounces that "people trained to kill cannot solve conflicts at a place of study".

The repression was also picked up by international media outlets.

Escalating the situation further, the JOH regime temporarily held the US anthropologist and human rights activist Adrienne Pine at the airport in Tegucigalpa.

In Nacaome, a police agent shot a rubber bullet from a motorcycle at the chest of the human rights defender Marlon García.

The human rights network REDHESUR filed a complaint at the regional CONADEH office and the MP in Nacaome against the police sub-commissioner Wilmer Jurandir Pineda Ordóñez for human rights violations in the context of the protests.

Defensores en Línea spoke with teacher Bayron Roberto Rodríguez who two weeks ago was beaten up by state security forces and then thrown into a river. "Teacher Bayron recalls that on that Thursday there was persecution of the riot police, they fired live bullets, and the population fled to save their lives. Sadly he did not run with luck, but rather he was caught by the repressive force of the State, being a victim of torture, pepper spray and among many blows, with one in the neck, lost consciousness. Finally "I woke up in the river, and a boy took me to the clinic, they said I convulsed but later I did not remember ..." he described, when asked what he remembered from that moment."

In the US, meanwhile, different sectors call for a reevaluation of US policy towards Honduras. US representative Jan Schakowsky writes in the Hill: "The United States has continued to support successive administrations in Honduras, even though elections have been biased by vote buying, fraud, and assassinations. The United States sends the Honduran military and police aid even though these security forces have been ordered to beat and shoot non-violent protesters and there are credible allegations of death squads formed to assassinate journalists and citizens working for social change. One of these citizens was the well-known environmental activist Berta Cáceres. No one is held accountable for these crimes. (...) Under the circumstances, it is shameful that our government continues to send aid to this corrupt and illegally-elected government in Honduras. The

security aid in particular is being used to lift up a dictatorial president who abuses power and implicates our country in the human rights abuses of his regime. It is high time for my colleagues in the House to co-sponsor H.R. 1945, the Berta Cáceres Human Rights in Honduras Act, which would cut off U.S. aid to the Honduran military and police until such time as their human rights violations cease and impunity ends for the crimes they have committed."

US representative Hank Johnson comes to a similar conclusion. "One of the reasons we have a crisis at the border is our funding of the Honduran military & police. In the name of #BertaCáceres, we need to consider cutting that funding."

And so does representative Ilhan Omar. "The military police in Honduras function as a hit squad. Hondurans are fleeing their dictatorship by the tens of thousands. We must stop arming this dictatorship until the human rights violations cease and the perpetrators are brought to justice.

The same call also comes from US civil society organizations. In a joint press release, they call on the Honduran government to "order all security forces to end immediately excessive use of force against protesters; withdraw military and Military Police from responding to any protests; disband the Military Police; ensure government agents end any threats and abuse against human rights defenders and journalists; and ensure cases against state agents for these abuses are promptly investigated and prosecuted"; and on the US State Department to "call on the Honduran government to end excessive use of force, respect the rights of Hondurans to protest, defend rights and report on the news, disband the Military Police, and ensure justice for human rights crimes. We call on the U.S. Embassy in Honduras to end its all-too-often deafening silence and publicly, regularly denounce the abuses taking place."
